JOB DESCRIPTION FOR TRACK DEPARTMENT

MACHINE OPERATOR CLASS (I, II, III) Must be able to operate or qualify to operate machine within class in a safe, efficient and productive manner within a reasonable amount of time as per B.M.W.E. Agreement. Responsible for the daily basic maintenance of the machine. Must be able to make minor repairs and assist the repairmen with other repairs. Must be qualified on NORAC Book of Rules and timetable instructions of the Transportation Department or able to pass exam. Must be able to complete all required field documentation and able to carry out all trackmen duties and other duties, as assigned. Must be able to read, write, speak and understand the English Language. Must be qualified Gang-Watchman; Roadway Worker qualified and conversant on TRO-5 Safety Rules. The successful bidder is required to supply the following minimum list of tools:

GANG WATCHMAN: Must be able to carry out all duties assigned in a safe, orderly and productive manner. Required to take instructions concerning Gang Safety, Track work and other duties from Assistant Foreman, Foreman, Assistant Supervisor, Supervisors and all officers of NJ Transit Rail Operations. Must ensure that all subordinates adhere to safety hazards and take corrective action as needed. Must be qualified on NJ TRANSIT Safety Rule Book and Roadway Worker. Must be able to read, write, speak and understand the English Language. Must have all the qualifications of a Trackman.

TRACKMAN: Must be able to carry out track work and other duties assigned in a safe, orderly and productive manner. Must be conversant with MW-4 Safety Rules, NJ TRANSIT Timetable, Rules of the Transportation Department and Roadway Worker. Must be able read, write, speak and understand the English Language. Must be qualified Gang-Watchman.

TRACKMAN/OPERATOR: Must be able to carry out track work and other duties as assigned in a safe, orderly and productive manner. Must be conversant with the TRO5 Safety Rules and Roadway Worker and Gang Watchman qualified. Must be able to read, write, and understand the English Language. Must have all tools listed for Machine Operators and be able to qualify on all hand operated track machines, such as, but not limited to, Rail Saw, Raw Drill, Tie Borer, and Nutter as well as perform maintenance and light running repairs on these machines.

WELDER: Must be able to pass written and practical tests administered by the Supervisor of Welding. Must be conversant with TRO-5 Safety Rules. Must be qualified on the NORAC Book of Rules and Timetable Instructions for the Transportation Department or able to pass exam. Must be able to complete all required field documentation and other duties, as assigned. Must have a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with necessary endorsement with no physical restrictions for the type of vehicle operated. Must be able to read, write and understand the English Language. Must be a qualified Gang-Watchman. Must possess all Welder Helper qualifications.

WELDER HELPER: Must be able to assist Welder in all phases of operation. Must be able to set up oxygen-acetylene regulators for examinations administered by the Supervisor of Welding. Must be qualified on the NORAC Book of Rules and Timetable Instructions for the Transportation Department or able to pass exam. Must be able to complete all required field documentation and other duties as assigned. Must have a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with necessary endorsement with no physical restrictions for the type of vehicle operated. Must be able to read, write and understand the English language. Must be a Roadway Worker qualified Gang-Watchman.

REPAIRMAN: Must have operating knowledge of equipment and be able to perform work in connection with general overhaul and repairs of engines, motors, hydraulic, pneumatic and mechanical components on all roadway machines and work equipment used on hydraulic, pneumatic and mechanical prints and schematics. Must be qualified on TRO-5 Safety Rule Book, NORAC Book of Rules of the Transportation Department and Roadway Worker. Must have valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with no physical restrictions for the type vehicle operated. Must be able to carry out all other duties assigned. Must be able to read, write, speak and understand the English Language. Successful bidders will be required to provide tools as set forth in Tool Agreement. See Equipment Supervisor for complete list of tools.

WELDING FOREMAN: Must possess all the qualifications of a Track Foreman and Welder.

VEHICLE OPERATOR: Must be able to carry out track work and all duties as assigned in a safe, orderly, and productive manner. Must be able to make light running repairs to assigned vehicles. Must be qualified on the NORAC Book of Rules and Timetable Instructions for the Transportation Department or able to pass exam. Must be qualified on TRO-5 Safety Rule Book. Must be able to complete all required field documentation and able to carry out all trackmen duties and other duties, as assigned. Must have a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with necessary endorsement with no physical restrictions for the type of vehicle operated. Must be able to read, write and understand the English Language. Must be Roadway Worker qualified Gang-Watchman.

TRACKMAN/CASUAL DRIVER: Must be able to carry out track work and all duties as assigned in a safe, orderly and productive manner. Must be qualified on TRO-5 Safety Rule Book and Roadway Worker in addition to the qualifications of a Trackman. Must have current Driver's License with no physical restriction for type vehicle to be operated and able to complete all required field documentation. Must be able to read, write, speak and understand the English Language.

FOREMAN: Must be qualified on the proper use of NJ TRANSIT MW4 and be FRA qualified or able to pass FRA Exam. Must be qualified on the NORAC Book of Rules of the Transportation Department or able to pass exam. Must qualify on physical characteristics for the territory assigned and also on TRO-5 Safety Rule Book and Roadway Worker. Responsible for the supervision and safety of all employees assigned to them. Instruct employees on the proper performance of their work ensuring that it is done in a safe, orderly and productive manner. Constantly inspects the work being performed to make certain that the track is safe for the passage of trains and promptly advises the assistant supervisor or supervisor in charge of any unusual conditions. Must ensure that all subordinates adhere to safety rules. Required to inspect job sites for cleanliness and safety hazards and take corrective action as needed. Should have a current driver license. Must be capable of completing all required field documentation and able to carry out all other duties that are assigned. Must possess the qualifications of both Assistant Foreman and Trackman. Must be able to read, write speak and understand the English language.

ASSISTANT FOREMAN: Must be qualified on the proper use of NJ TRANSIT MW4 and be FRA qualified or able to pass FRA Exam. Must be qualified on the NORAC Book of Rules of the Transportation Department or able to pass exam. Must qualify on physical characteristics for the territory assigned and Roadway Worker and conversant on TRO-5 Safety Rule Book. Responsible for the supervision and safety of all employees assigned to them. Instruct employees on the proper performance of their work ensuring that it is done in a safe, orderly and productive manner. Constantly inspects and work being performed to make certain that the track is safe for the passage of trains. Must ensure that all subordinates adhere to safety rules. Required to inspect job site for cleanliness and safety and take corrective action. Should have a current driver's license. Must be capable of completing all required field documentation and able to carry out all other duties that are assigned. Must be able to read, write, speak and understand the English language.
